Would you like to meet people in your area? Would you like to do something with other people in your spare time? Do you have any questions about life in Switzerland?

You can get to know your local area better, meet new people and improve your German with the «come together» programme from the Zurich Red Cross. It's free of charge.

You will meet up with a volunteer or a volunteer family for around two hours once a week. The meet-ups take place in the Winterthur and Andelfingen region.

Volunteers are people who help with a task out of interest and enjoyment. «come together» volunteers are people and families who have lived in the region for a while.

You...

- ...are a person, couple or family
- ...have an F or B permit (refugee)
- ...are at least 18 years old
- ...speak German (around A1 level)
- ...live in the districts of Winterthur or Andelfingen
- ...cannot search for work or educational opportunities (e.g. because you are caring for young children, are elderly or for health reasons)

or you...

- ...are new to the Winterthur and Andelfingen region and have not yet reached A2-level proficiency in German.
